



Sun Conure

Care sheet

Caging needed: A cage at least 30" W X 30" L X 36"H. The metal bars of the cage should be strong and no greater than $\frac{3}{4}$ " apart. The larger the cage the better. These birds enjoy being out of the cage and being able to interact with people.

Accessories: Food dish, water bowl, perches and toys are necessary. At least two perches are needed, one high in the cage and one low near the food and water. Provide a variety of toys to occupy your Conure as well as a cuttle bone.

Diet: A balanced pellet food should be the majority of a Conure's diet. Fruits, leafy greens, and root vegetables should be offered. They will only eat what they need of the pellet food, but the fruits and veggies should be limited to $\frac{1}{8}$ - $\frac{1}{4}$ cup in the morning and at night.

Talking ability: Some of these birds can learn to mimic sounds.

Misc: Proper exercise is needed for Sun Conures. They are very active and need room to fly. They should have at least 3 hours out of the cage each day. Sun Conures can learn tricks and require positive reinforcement while training. These birds are super friendly and cuddly when trained properly. They need a normal amount of time with their owners as they need companionship.

Average lifespan: 15-20 years when cared for properly.
